Petition Complaint Regarding Sewer Services in Leisure Lake, Jackson County

To: Jackson County Board of Supervisors

We, the undersigned residents of Leisure Lake in Jackson County, hereby submit this formal complaint regarding the ongoing and unacceptable issues with the sewer services provided to our community. After multiple attempts to address these concerns informally, we are left with no choice but to raise these matters in a formal capacity. The following issues are impacting residents' financial well-being and quality of life, and we demand immediate attention and corrective action.

1. Excessive Charges and Service Disparity

Residents of Leisure Lake are currently being charged approximately \$70 per month for sewer services. In comparison, other communities in Jackson County pay between \$40 and \$80 per month for at least two services (water and sewer). This significant cost disparity is unjustifiable, particularly given that Leisure Lake residents receive far fewer services. Moreover, property owners are additionally burdened with paying the electric costs to operate the sewer system, bringing their total monthly costs to more than \$70. This excessive cost and lack of value for services rendered must be addressed immediately.

2. Monopoly and Lack of Service Flexibility

Leisure Lake residents are essentially trapped in a monopoly with the current sewer provider. We are not permitted to install alternative sewer systems, nor can we opt out of the service when it is not needed. Unlike other communities in Jackson County that have the ability to adjust their service levels, Leisure Lake residents are locked into continuous service and billing. For seasonal property owners, this is especially burdensome, as they are required to keep the sewer system running year-round —often at their own expense—despite not needing the service during the off-season. One such resident, who acts as the hub for sewer services in the area, is forced to cover the electric costs of running the system for others while still paying the full monthly sewer fee. This practice is financially inequitable and demands immediate reform.

3. Charges for Unused Sewer Systems

There have been cases where parts of the sewer system, which were no longer in use, were removed from certain properties, yet residents were still charged the full monthly sewer fee. This is both misleading and unjust, as it constitutes charging residents for services they no longer receive. This practice is financially burdensome and should be rectified immediately.

4. Broken Promises and Rising Costs

When the sewer systems were first installed, residents were assured that their monthly fees would not exceed \$55. However, the current monthly charges have risen to \$70, and the number of sewer systems has increased without any clear justification for this price hike. These rising costs directly contradict the promises made at the time of installation and should be revisited for fairness and transparency.

5. Out-of-County Billing

The sewer services are billed by a company located in Dubuque County, which raises significant questions about the transparency and accountability of this billing process. Why are Jackson County residents being billed by an entity outside the county? Keeping these funds within Jackson County would not only support the local economy but also foster greater transparency and accountability in the billing process.

6. Lack of Billing Transparency and Paperless System Fees

Our monthly bills are identical each month, with no clear explanation for the fixed charges. In addition, since the transition to a paperless billing system, residents are charged an additional fee to request a paper invoice. This is an unnecessary and unreasonable practice that adds to the already excessive costs faced by residents. We believe that local management of the billing system could reduce these unnecessary fees and improve transparency.

7. Lack of Adequate Representation

We are deeply concerned that our local government has not adequately addressed these issues or taken steps to represent the best interests of Leisure Lake residents. The lack of action on these issues is unacceptable, and we urge our representatives to take immediate steps to advocate for fair and affordable sewer services for our community.

Request for Immediate Action

In light of the above concerns, we formally request the following actions:

- 1. A full investigation into the fairness and justification of current sewer charges for Leisure Lake residents.
- 2. A review of the billing structure to ensure that residents are only charged for services they are receiving, and that any unnecessary fees, including those for paperless billing, are eliminated.
- 3. Immediate adjustments to allow residents, particularly seasonal property owners, to have the flexibility to shut off or modify their sewer service when it is not needed.

- 4. A transparent explanation for the involvement of an out-of-county billing entity, and a review of whether this practice is in the best interest of the residents of Jackson County.
- 5. A commitment to holding the service provider accountable for their promises and pricing, and ensuring that all fees align with the original agreement made with the community.

We trust that our concerns will be taken seriously, and we expect a prompt response detailing the steps that will be taken to resolve these issues.
