# Call to Order

Chair Flagel called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m.

## Action on March 5, 2025 EIRUSS Agenda

## **Droessler Subdivision/Spruce Creek Park**

## A. Project Status Update

Jobgen stated the project is going well and residents are paying their bill on time.

## **B.** Review/Action on Anstoetter Construction Pay Application #11

Becklin stated that this is the final pay application for the project and the release of retainage. Jobgen stated that the interim loan has been extended with the bank to March 31<sup>st</sup>, which was the reason for the special meeting. Becklin noted that the pay app cannot be paid until March 13<sup>th</sup>.

Motion by George, seconded by Gaul for approval and direct Specht to sign the Anstoetter Construction Pay Application #11. Motion passed unanimously.

#### C. Review/Action on Resolution to Amend EIRUSS/ECIA Agreement to \$105,000

Jobgen stated that the previous agreement was set for \$100,000. This agreement allowed ECIA staff to work on EIRUSS activities. As the project was coming to completion, it was noted that the staff amount was slightly exceeded. Per USDA, a resolution is needed to amend the agreement. This agreement will then be passed to ECIA for approval and signature.

Motion by George, seconded by Corkery to pass Resolution to Amend EIRUSS/ECIA Agreement to \$105,000. Motion passed unanimously.

#### D. Review/Action on Petesch Public Utility Easement

Jobgen explained that during construction the water line was moved, which avoided additional roadway costs. Therefore, a new easement needed to be signed. The Petesch family has signed the document and staff will have the document recorded once there is EIRUSS approval.

Motion by George, seconded by Gaul to approve Petesch Public Utility Easement. Motion passed unanimously.
