Property History

- City obtained ownership of 0.12 acres in 2020 of 211 and 213 E Broadway Street
- Structures were built in 1910
- In 1936, structures were converted from City Hall/Fire Dept. to commercial use
- City acquired properties in 2020 because of years of neglect, public safety concerns and hazardous structural and environmental conditions
- In 2022, a Site Reuse Plan was created based on community feedback, outlining options for expansion of the City's municipal services on the property

Redevelopment

- City applied to ECIA for EPA Brownfields Assessment and Planning grant funds
- Phase I Assessment conducted in 2021
- Phase II Assessment conducted in 2022 to identify potential contaminants of concern in soil and/or groundwater
- Phase II found arsenic contamination slightly elevated exceeding applicable Statewide Standards based on unrestricted land use
- IDNR review determined no further action because of the planned reuse as commercial
- Phase I indicated the likely presence of asbestos and further inspection found asbestos containing material (ACM) in building materials requiring abatement
- In January 2022, a structural engineer deemed the structures unstable for safe abatement
- City applied to ECIA and IDNR for U.S. EPA
 Brownfields funds and was awarded \$100,000 in
 ECIA Brownfields grant funds and \$24,999 in IDNR
 Brownfields grant funds
- RACM Demolition Completed April 2023
